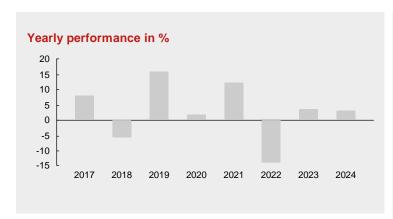


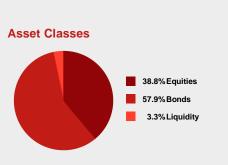

#### **Investment Goal**

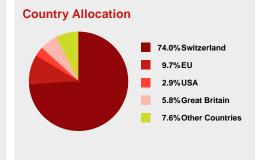

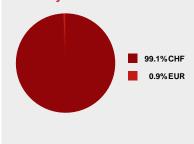
